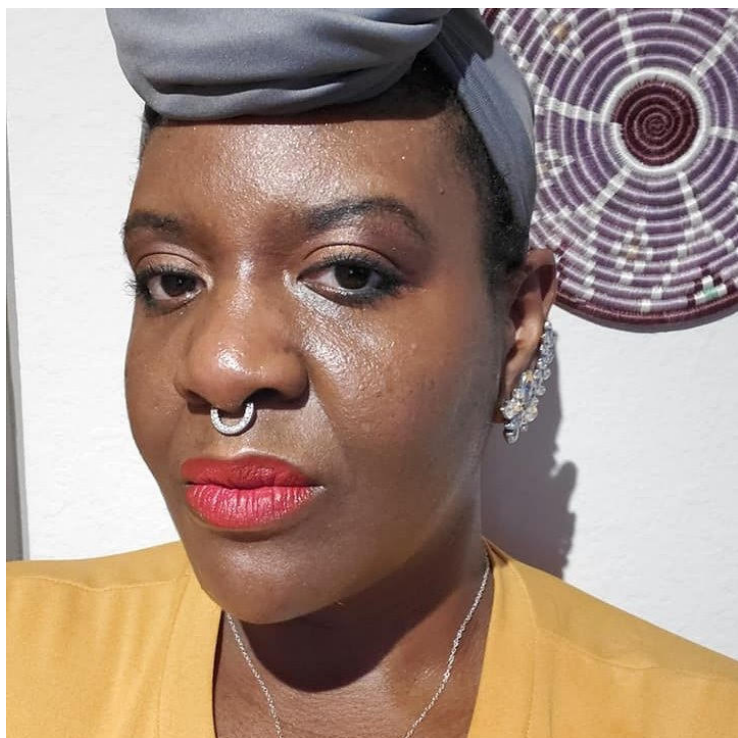


UCSB'S HISTORY OF ART & ARCHITECTURE PRESENTS:
